ITINERARY

Tour starts Tuesdays 9.30am Bath Spa railway station



Day 1

We have morning coffee in Bath, visit the village of Meryton, Meryton Assembly rooms, Darcy's university, The Bell at Bromley, supper in period costume at Longbourn with tour of interior and gardens, the church where Lizzie marries Darcy and Lizzie's walks, dancing in the house to dances from P&P.

Overnight near Longbourn

Day 2

We visit Netherfield, Darcy's London, Hunsford Parsonage where we have afternoon tea and a full tour including the room where Darcy first proposed. Overnight in Hunsford and nearby



Day 3 We visit Rosings and Pemberley interior. Overnight in the Peak District

Day 4 We visit Lizzie's Peak District and Pemberley. Plus we visit EITHER the village of Lambton OR the actual Georgian carriages used by the BBC (including Mr Darcy's).

Tour ends Fridays 17.00pm Manchester Piccadilly railway station

ACCOMMODATION TYPES

The prices for the tour vary depending on accommodation – see below. We take 50% at the time of booking and 50% balance 10 weeks before your tour.

We usually have more ladies than men on tour, and we never have more than

23 clients on any tour.

Bennet - £699 per person

These rooms *must be booked by 2 people* and you will share a double bed (or twin beds if available) with your room-mate. This category is perfect for best friends, mums and daughters and those who (just like Lizzie and Jane) – are happy to share! You will stay in small but lovely B&Bs.



Bingley - £799 per person

As above – but with single accommodation.

Lady Catherine - £1170 per person

Single occupancy in locations actually used in filming OR top class luxury hotels. The first to book will be offered the option to stay in Lizzie's bedroom in Hunsford Parsonage as seen on film. Includes priority check-in at every location, first drop-off at hotels and last pick-up, also includes your private supper at Hunsford, and lunch at the Assembly rooms in Meryton OR Colin Firth's secret hideaway in Meryton.

If two Lady Catherine's prefer to share a room there is a reduction to **£997 per person** for a double or twin room.

Note on accommodation; On some nights you will be given the choice to stay in an actual filming location such as Hunsford Parsonage. Please note that not every bedroom is en-suite – and if this is an important consideration do tell us when you book and we will relocate you to a luxury hotel nearby.

INCLUDED for all categories

Morning coffee in Bath, supper in Longbourn plus welcome champagne, hotel accommodation, breakfasts, all entrance fees, afternoon tea at all coach travel between locations.

Typically water, tea and coffee are included with meals that are included in

the itinerary.

EXCLUDED

Transport to and from the start and end of the tour. Gratuities to guides.
Meals and drinks other than those specified on the itinerary, period costume.

A note about your personal tour costs - wine costs about £5 per glass, a light lunch £8 per person, a light supper in the hotel £12, OR supper to a hotel restaurant allow £25. Coffees and drinks allow £5 per day and don't forget money for lovely P&P mementoes in the shops!!



Q: Is the tour good value?

A: Our tours are world exclusives and we have access to places the public cannot visit. When people have been on tour with us, they say the tours are worth far more than they paid!

Q: How do I get to the start and end of the tour?

A: Our tours start and end at main railway stations. P&P starts at Bath Spa station and ends at Manchester Piccadilly station.

We arrange flights, hotels and transfers for you if you require. Just ask us or email leighann@pandptours.co.uk

Q: Do I get to wear Regency costume?

A: We encourage you to wear a Regency accessory (or even outfit) for our supper at Longbourn, but it is up to you! Most people do dress up, or wear a headband or an accessory.

Regency gowns and accessories can be hired from us and we also supply period costumes to order through our website.

Q: How do I pay?

A: By cheque to P and P Tours, or by a transfer to our bank account, or by Paypal (+4% fee) or credit card (+4% fee).

Q: When will I receive a detailed itinerary?

A: Six weeks before your trip. As soon as we receive your deposit we will send out your confirmation pack in the post.

Q: Are gratuities included?

A: No, tips for your guides and driver are not included. If you feel that your guides have provided excellent service, we suggest £5 - £10 per day per guest.

Q: How much luggage is allowed?

A: In order to get to the locations down small lanes we have to use a midi coach. There is only space for one suitcase and one hand luggage item per person so that we can fit it on the coach!
